Combine Demolition Derby Rules

Registration Deadline 6/1/18

Class: Judges will assign each combine to one of two classes depending on make and model (size) and number of combine entered. Classes limited to eight combines each, first come first entered.

5:00 PM Mandatory Pit Meeting

6:00 PM Demo starts

General Rules

1. No Storage of Combines on Mountain Springs Arena grounds Before Monday June 12th , all combines must be off grounds by Wednesday June.21st
2. Only Three Persons (Driver, Owner, and Mechanic) That Sign the Release Form Will Be Permitted in the Pit Area or On the track.
3. Drivers Must Be 18 Years or Older to Participate.
4. No One Under Age 16 Permitted in Pit Area! No Exceptions.
5. Injuries, if any, No Matter How Small Must Be Immediately Reported to the Official In Charge.
6. No Passengers Riding On or In Combines at Any Time!!!! (This Includes Pit Area, Parking Lot and Driveways of Mt. Springs.)

Combine Requirements

1. All glass and lights must be removed from the unit.
2. Fuel tank must be mounted in grain tank.
3. No 4WD units will be allowed.
4. Cab door must be chained or welded shut.
5. No duals are allowed, no calcium in tires for ballast, must be Ag type tires, no earthmover tires.
6. Remove ladder, unloading auger and choppers.
7. Must have cab or roll cage.
8. All drive belts to separator and head must be removed.
9. Bars must be welded on cab across the front and sides to protect the driver.
10. Radiator must contain water only.
11. Batteries must be mounted in a secure box.
12. No sharp edges to intentionally puncture opponents' tires will be allowed.

Header Requirements

1. All combines must have a header, maximum head with 16ft.
2. Head must be fixed between 18 and 24 inches off the ground with no float or hydraulic action.
3. All grain tables must have the reel, sickles, sheet metal points and guards removed.
4. Corn heads must have sheet metal points, corn snouts and snapping rolls removed.

Event rules

1. Derby will consist of heats based on number of entries.
2. All combines will be inspected and approved at pit meeting.
3. Derby officials may accept or reject any or all entries.
4. All drivers must be 18 years of age or older.
5. All drivers must wear a helmet and safety belt.
6. No radio helmet or radio communications with driver during the contest.
7. The decisions of the judge and derby officials will be final.
8. No direct hits to the driver's area.
9. Raising or tipping another combine more then 10 inches off the ground may be grounds for disqualification. Do Not try to upset combines.
10. Any combine not making a hit within three minutes is disqualified. Officials will give 1 warning.
11. If you lose your headed you are disqualified.
12. A lath stick will be mounted within the driver's reach, stick must be broken off when driver is unable to continue. No deliberate hitting of disabled combines that have stick broken off.
13. All movement of combines must be halted upon signal of officials or announcer in case of fire, injury or official's concerns for safety.
14. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification.
15. No alcohol or drugs allowed.
16. Drivers are responsible for their crew.
17. Officials and competitors will work together to make this a safe and entertaining event for the fans and competitors.
